



2019 STUDENT FEES AND CONTRIBUTIONS

Abbotsford Primary School makes every effort to keep the sort of items that need to be purchased at a minimum gaining considerable savings to families. In line with the Department of Education and Training, parents are expected to make an annual payment to supplement the cost of your child's educational program in 2019.

The Department of Education and Training (DET) provides funding through the Student Resource Package. This means that we receive bulk funding for the cost of the school's educational programs. The funding covers staff salaries, professional development, building maintenance, cleaning and sanitation supplies, energy, administration and contributions to our educational programs. Even with the additional income of fundraising and the hire of school facilities, these funds do not meet the cost of the quality education programs we wish to provide for your children.

School Council has determined the Essential Student Items cost for 2019 will be \$240.00. This cost includes stationary, work books, paper, art/craft supplies and technology equipment.

Excursions (transport & entrance) are not included in the Essential Student Items, although they are essential to our curriculum. All students are expected to attend and families are asked to pay for these as the activities occur through the year and are vital to the curriculum.

We have also asked families to make a voluntary contribution of \$50.00 to support investment in library resources.

Abbotsford Primary School appreciates that families may at times, experience financial difficulty in meeting payment requests. A number of support options are available to families experiencing financial difficulty in meeting payment requests. These include the School's Second – Hand Uniform Shop, State Schools Relief and/or the Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund (CSEF).
